EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER EXTENDING STATE OF CIVIL EMERGENCY

I, George A. Long, as City Manager of the City of Bartow, issue the following emergency administrative order pursuant to § 252.38(3)(a), Florida Statutes (2019), §§ 26-26, *et seq.*, *Code of Ordinances of the City of Bartow, Florida*, and Resolution 20-4041-R of the City Commission of the City of Bartow, Florida dated March 16, 2020:

Whereas, by Executive Order of the Governor of Florida, the State of Florida is presently in a State of Emergency as of the date and time of this Administrative Order; and

Whereas, by Order of the County Manager and Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners, Polk County is presently in a State of Emergency as of the date and time of this Administrative Order; and

Whereas, Resolution 20-4041-R of the City of Commission of the City of Bartow is currently in effect, as of the date and time of this Administrative Order;

Now, therefore, pursuant to the delegation of authority from the City Commission of the City of Bartow by § 3(c) of Resolution 20-4041-R, and the provisions of the *State Emergency Management Act*, § 252.38(3)(a)5., Florida Statutes (2019), I hereby extend the duration of and/or renew the effective period of the City of Bartow's State of Civil Emergency relating to COVID-19 for seven (7) additional days. The period covered by this order begins at 5:00 P.M. on Monday, March 23, 2020 and ends at 4:59 PM on Monday, March 30, 2020. Emergency orders to and through E.A.O. Number 2020-01, including amendments or additions thereto, shall be effective during this extended/renewed State of Civil Emergency.
