

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING UPON THE PETITION OF THE OWNER THEREOF APPROXIMATELY 369.3 ACRES OF PROPERTY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF HIGHWAY 60 EAST; SOUTH SIDE OF GERBER DAIRY ROAD; AND 3,600' WEST OF RIFLE RANGE ROAD IN SECTIONS 29 THRU 32, TOWNSHIP 29S, RANGE 26E, POLK COUNTY, FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR SCRIVENER'S ERROR; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE UPON FINAL PASSAGE
